March 11, 2020

6:00 p.m.: Public hearing regarding ATV/UTV ordinance. In attendance was Lee Schmiling. The Town Board discussed the adoption of the same ordinance as the County. The ordinance, if adopted, would go into effect as soon as the signs are delivered and located in the Township. Public hearing closed at 6:30 p.m.

A motion was made to approve the ATV/UTV ordinance by Tom. Seconded by Ken. Motion Carried. **Ordinance No.0214-2020** has been adopted by the Town Board of Ahnapee. The board adopted the All-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance pursuant to the authority of Wis. Stats. 23.33(11) and 350.18. This will go into effect as soon as signs are delivered and properly located throughout the Town of Ahnapee. Gary will contact the sheriff's department to inform them of this action.

Carnot Road /Carnot Drive signage issue was discussed.

The Town had applied for a grant to do roadwork but did not receive the grant monies.

Road sweeping will be done. Also, of concern, was having hand sanitizer and wipes for the election. Sharon will try to purchase some for the Town.
