Minutes: May 13, 2020

The May meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Paape. Present for roll call were Supervisor Tom Stoller, Supervisor Ken Draves, Treasurer Shelly Anderson and Clerk Sharon Grosbeier. Also attending was Attorney Tyler Pluff.

The Agenda was approved as printed, with a motion from Tom Stoller and seconded by Ken Draves. The minutes were approved with a motion from Ken and a second by Tom. The financial report presented by the Treasurer was also approved with a motion from Tom and a second by Ken.

Tyler Pluff, from the Pinkert Law Firm in Sturgeon Bay was introduced as one of the Town's attorneys that will succeed retired Attorney Randy Nesbitt. Tyler spoke briefly regarding his position with the firm and his history.

A speed limit change proposal for the new Willow Road bridge was discussed. The proposed speed limit would decrease from 55mph. to 45mph. This change would also be cost effective to our town. A motion was made by Supervisor Tom Stoller to make the speed limit change from 55 mph. to 45 mph. on Willow Road. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Ken Draves. Motion was carried, all yes.

Also discussed was a bridge aid petition for Willow Road noting the reason to ask the County to pay their share. Motion to approve was made by Ken. Seconded by Tom. Motion carried.

The Washington Road Local Improvement project is ready to go out to bids.

Also noted was the road inspection report. Among roads to be considered are Jefferson Rd., West Wilson Rd., Orange Tree Lane, Cedar Road and Carnot Road patches. More discussion will be done at the June 10th meeting.

Tom made a motion to pay bills. Ken seconded. Motion carried.

Ken made a motion to adjourn. Tom seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
