Minutes: June 10, 2020

The June meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Paape. Present for roll call were Supervisor Tom Stoller, Supervisor Ken Draves, Treasurer Shelly Anderson and Clerk Sharon Grosbeier. Also attending was Brian Paplham from Scott Construction.

Also discussed was a cold mix wedge at the cost of \$11,244.00 on Cedar Road, from Washington Road to County Line Road. Tom made a motion to approve the project. Ken seconded. Motion carried, all yes.

Beer and liquor license applications for Renee Ebert, B's Lighthouse, James Tebon, Black Ash Gun Club and the Algoma Hunting & Fishing Club were presented. Bartender licenses were also reviewed and Ken made a motion to approve all. Motion was seconded by Tom. Motion carried. All, yes.

Discussion of work done on Jefferson Road, West of County D, is tabled until the July 8th meeting.

Zoning issues were discussed regarding junk, unlicensed vehicles on a property on Washington Road. Another concern was the amount of garbage surrounding a residence on Adams Road, Sharon will check into this further

Ken made a motion to pay bills. Tom seconded. Motion carried.

Tom made a motion to adjourn. Ken seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
