

Town of Ahnapee  
Minutes of July 8, 2020

The July meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Paape. Present for roll call were Supervisor Tom Stoller, Supervisor Ken Draves, Treasurer Shelly Anderson and Clerk Sharon Grosbeier. Also present was Matt Wotochek.

The agenda was approved as printed with a motion from Ken. Seconded by Tom. Motion carried. The minutes were approved with a motion from Tom and seconded by Ken. Motion carried. The financial report was presented and reviewed. Motion to approve was made by Ken and seconded by Tom. Motion carried.

Matt Wotochek questioned the restrictions on the building permit issued to Dean Ferron on County M. His concern was the piling of wood and broken pallets along the property line. Matt stated it was unsightly when looking out of their upstairs room window. Sharon stated that the building permit did not have any restrictions other than following the ordinance. She stated that Dean was to meet certain requirements before the building permit could be issued. Dean Ferron did meet the requirements set forth by the zoning committee and the building permit was issued accordingly.

The Washington Road project between County D and County M was discussed. Estimated cost of the project is about \$105,000.00. Questions were concerning how much to borrow and where to borrow it from. Motion was made by Ken to borrow the \$100,000.00 on a ten- year term. Tom seconded the motion. Motion carried. Gary will look at the Wisconsin Trust Fund for interest rates and terms.

A firm is considering the Town of Ahnapee as a possible tower site. Gary requested that Sharon send a copy of the Tower Ordinance to the firm.

Election equipment will be replaced during 2021. The County will pay half and the Town will be responsible for the other half. Final figures are not available but will be considered when preparing the budget for 2021.

The Town Board went into closed session with a motion by Tom. Seconded by Ken. After the discussion, Tom made a motion to go back into open session. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried.

No action was taken on the Romdenne issue and the Board will revisit the issue at a later date.

Ken made a motion to pay bills. Seconded by Tom. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Tom. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
