Minutes: August 19, 2020

The August meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Paape. Present for roll call were Supervisor Tom Stoller, Supervisor Ken Draves, Treasurer Shelly Anderson and Clerk Sharon Grosbeier. Also attending was Randy Ebert.

The Agenda was approved as printed, with a motion from Ken and seconded by Tom. The minutes were approved with a motion from Ken and a second by Tom. The financial report presented by the Treasurer was also approved with a motion from Tom and a second by Ken.

Sharon had questions about billings from the Algoma Fire and Rescue. This matter is tabled until the September meeting so more information is available.

Randy Ebert was invited to attend the meeting to discuss issues with Jefferson Road. Randy suggested that leaving the road graveled through the winter and monitor it to see what happens. Gary asked if Randy would pay for damage done to Jefferson. Although, he was not in agreement, Randy and the Board decided that \$5,000.00 would be the final figure to be billed to Ebert Enterprises for the road repair.

Randy also questioned the Board if the Town was open to having towers in the township. Gary's response was yes and that it would be a Conditional Use according to the Ordinance.

The Washington Road paving will begin in about two weeks. The area to be paved is between County D and County M. Both approaches at Washington Road bridge will be done as well. Sharon emailed the request for the General Loan Application requesting a ten- year loan in the amount of \$100,000.00. Bridge inspection has been completed. Gary stated that the bridge maintenance would be low for 2021.

At 7:45 the board went into closed session. The Romdenne matter was discussed. Tom made a motion to go back into open session at 8:00 p.m. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried.

Ken made a motion to pay bills. Tom seconded. Motion carried.

Tom made a motion to adjourn. Ken seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:27 p.m. Next meeting date will be September 9, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.
