

October 14,2020 Minutes  
Town of Ahnapee

The monthly meeting of the Town of Ahnapee was called to order by Chairman Gary Paape at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at the Ahnapee Town Hall, 303 N Water St., Algoma, WI. Present for roll call were Ken Draves, Tom Stoller, Shelly Anderson, and Sharon Grosbeier. Also attending was Sharon Pavlik in regard to the zoning administrator position. Other attendees were Carol Braun and Nathan Wolf.

Upon review of the agenda, Tom made a motion to accept the agenda. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried. The minutes of the September meeting were reviewed. Ken made a motion to approve. Seconded by Tom. Motion carried. Treasurer Shelly gave the financial report and Tom made a motion to accept the report. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried.

Three CSM's, Certified Survey Maps, were presented to the Board. The CSM's involved land sales. CSM for Carol Braun: Ken made a motion to approve. Seconded by Tom. Motion carried. CSM for Nathan Wolf: Tom made a motion to approve. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried. CSM for Rick Kornely: Tom made a motion to approve. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried.

Sharon Pavlik attended the meeting expressing her interest in assuming the zoning administrator position. Sharon has experience in a demanding office position and recently purchased a home in the Town of Ahnapee. The Board will consider her request after they meet with other interested parties.

Treasurer Shelly Anderson expressed options for property owners to pay their property taxes. She suggested that pay by mail would be the best option due to the Covid-19 pandemic. A decision will be made by November 11<sup>th</sup>.

With the November 3<sup>rd</sup> election coming up, Sharon expressed concern about the flow of voters entering and exiting the building through one door. That would not allow the social distancing. The solution would be to put a sidewalk from the side exit door to the front of the building. This would enable a flow of voters in and out of the building with social distancing being followed.

Tom made a motion to have the sidewalk done asap. Ken seconded. Motion carried.

Gary will contact Dennis Mertens from Mertens Construction and Concrete to see if this project could be completed prior to the election and at what cost to the town.

A motion was made to pay bills by Ken. Seconded by Tom. Motion carried.

Tom made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried.
