

November 11, 2020 Minutes

The November meeting of the Town of Ahnapee was called to order by Chairman Gary Paape. Present were Supervisors Ken Draves and Tom Stoller, Treasurer Shelly Anderson and Clerk Sharon Grosbeier. Also attending the meeting was Lee Haasch.

Agenda was reviewed and revised to move number 10, zoning administrator position, moved to between number 7 & 8. Motion was made by Tom to approve agenda and minutes. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried. Treasurers financial report was reviewed. Motion to accept was made by Ken. Seconded by Tom. Motion carried. All yes.

Lee Haasch attended the meeting expressing interest in assuming the zoning administrator position. Gary made a revision to the minutes of the joint meeting with the Town of Forestville, simply giving more detail.

There will be no IOH meeting and no WTA meeting due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Sharon discussed record retention in regard to how long and what records should be kept. Sharon contacted the Wisconsin Towns Association regarding a template ordinance. This was tabled until the January meeting.

Gary discussed the recent presidential election. Thank you to the poll workers for a job well done.

The next meeting will be held on Thursday, December 10th at 6:30 p.m. at the Ahnapee Town Hall.

Tom made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Ken seconded. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Ken. Tom seconded. Motion carried.
