Sandy Johnson discussed the stop sign at Birch Road and Fremont Road. Sandy brought in a petition requesting the stop sign be removed. Further discussion will be on the May agenda.

Sherry Kuss is concerned about Peach Tree Lane and what can be done to improve that road. Russ offered some input as to what could possibly be done. But the options did not involve anything that the Town could do. However, Gary stated that the road inspection report did include Peach Tree Lane among many others that need repairs.

A mailbox post was damaged on Elder Drive due to the heavy snow being plowed. The Town's policy is to reimburse a property owner up to \$40.00 for mail box damage. Gary made a motion to pay the \$40.00. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried.

Road inspection was done prior to this meeting. The Town Board should have bids back for the possible sealcoating. A lengthy list of projects for road repair was presented.

Greg Panger attended requesting approval of a Certified Survey Map for property on Washington Road. Tom made a motion to approve the request. Seconded by Ken. Motion carried.

Gary discussed the American Rescue Plan which provides monies to Towns for specific uses. When more information becomes, the Town Board will have options as to what can be done.

The annual meeting date for 2022 will be April 20th at 6:30 p.m.

The May monthly meeting will be on Monday, May 10th at 6:30 p.m.

Ken made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Tom seconded. Motion carried.
